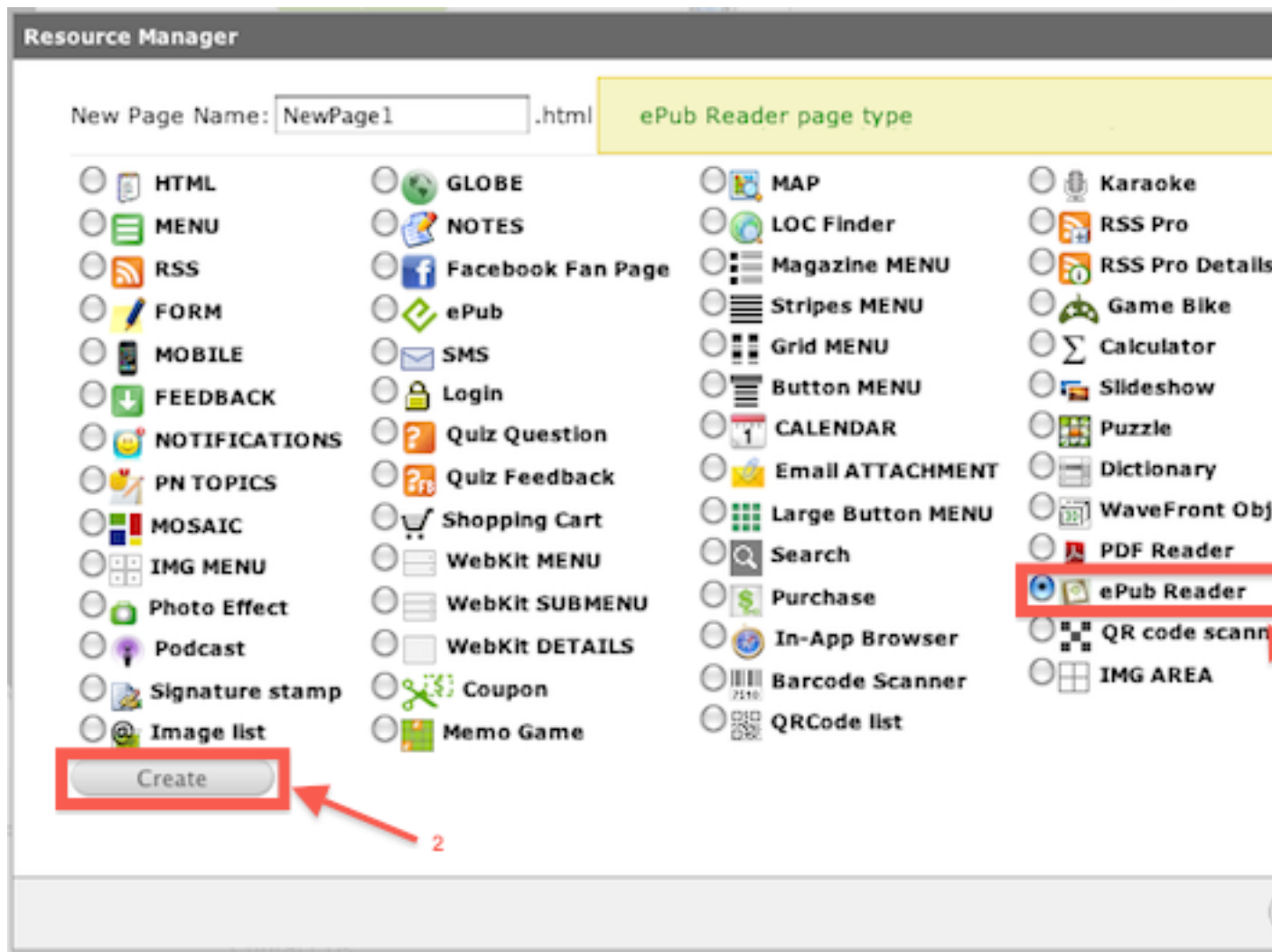


## ePub Reader - Tutorial and Features

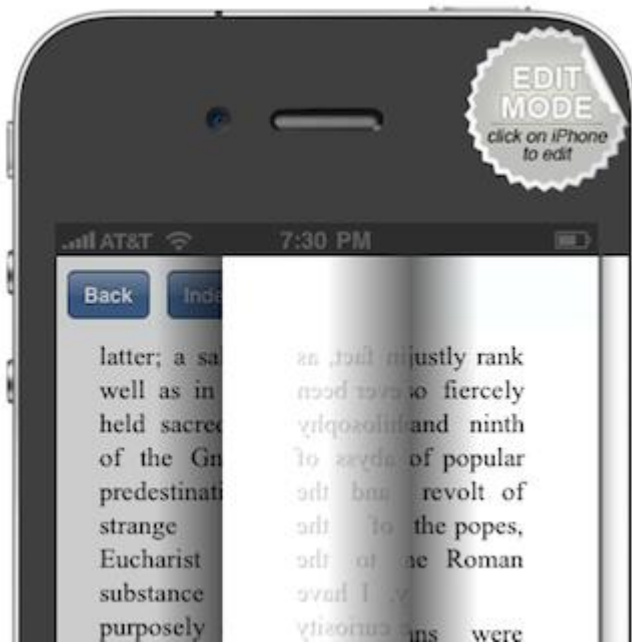
Now, it's very easy to add an eBook in your application

\* The last step is to choose from Resource Manager your eBook.



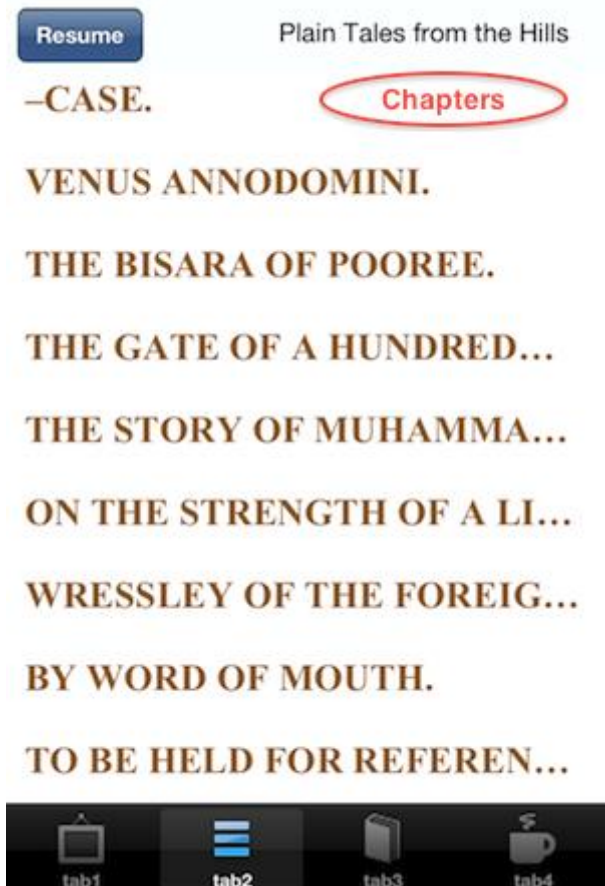
**\*\*NOTE:** Only .epub file type accepted.

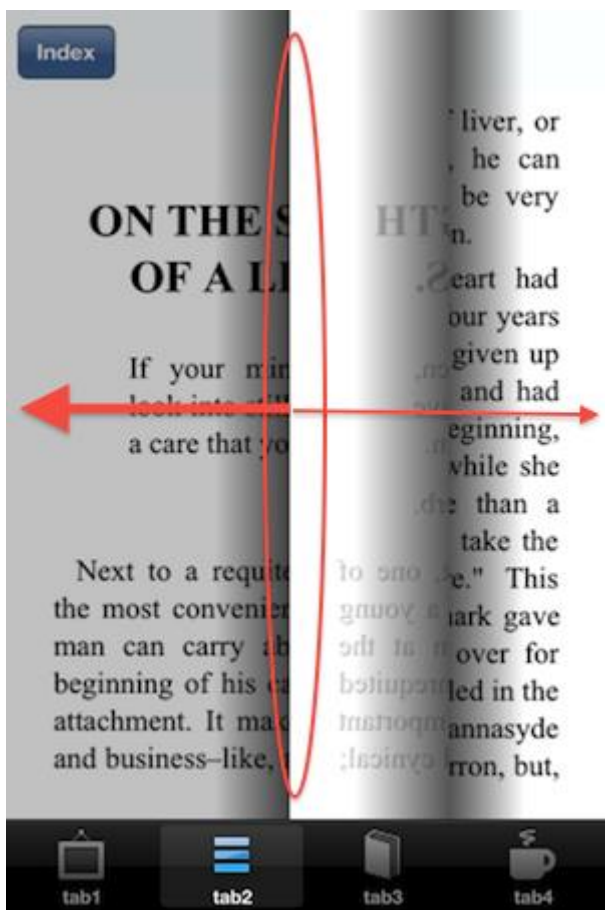
